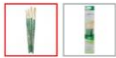

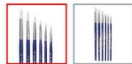

HARDBOARD

This is to tape your paper to. An 11 x 14 size is optimal. This can be any hard surface that is water-resistant, such as a wooden board, MDF board, or an extra kitchen cutting board you may have at home.

MASKING FLUID

Any brand works! You may also see this product called frisket or drawing gum.



OPTIONAL:

Since the frisket ruins brushes, I'd suggest getting something like these silicone shapers. You don't need a set; just a medium one is enough. Or if you have old brushes at home, that will work too:



Miscellaneous:
