

Hand Quilting for Beginners

Supply List

- Hexagon plastic template
- Quilting needles (usually size 7-10)
- Quilting clips
- White hand Quilting Thread (usually a cotton, 2 ply, 30 weight thread with a wax or resin finish that prevents knotting)
- Quilting large safety pins
- Taylor chalk
- Material Scissor (sharp and for material only)
- 100% cotton batting crib size
- Glue sticks (white or clear washable)

Dollar Store List

- Paper scissors
- Composition notebook
- Pencil and/or pen
- 5 sheets of card stock paper or a pack of large index cards
- Plastic shoe box or craft box to hold supplies

Fabric Store—See chart on the next page.

Material tips:

- All fabric should be 100% cotton.
- Craft stores have a quilting section of material, just ask store clerk.
- Please wash and dry all fabrics by machine before class. This will shrink the material and remove all stiffness.
- Pick light and dark coordinating colors.
- Pick different patterns.

Fabric 1 Quilt Top	1½ yards	Plain solid <u>White</u> (no pattern) quilting muslin	\$3 per yard
Fabric 2 Quilt Backing and Borders	2½ yards	Solid <i>coordinating</i> <u>color</u> (no pattern) quilting muslin	\$6 per yard
Fabric 3 Hexagon Flower	½ yard	To make 4 hexagon flowers. Should have a small printed pattern. <u>Light</u> colored coordinating material	\$8 per yard
Fabric 4 Hexagon Flower	½ yard	To make 4 hexagon flowers. Should have a small printed pattern. <u>Light</u> colored coordinating material	\$8 per yard
Fabric 5 Hexagon Flower	½ yard	To make 3 hexagon flowers. Should have a small printed pattern. <u>Dark</u> colored coordinating material	\$8 per yard
